 - New members introduce themselves
- Mystery Visitor. ET/SIA Canvas Access
 - Laura Duvall speaking about large classes and ET/SIA programs. New policy regarding needing permission to add someone who isn't a student into the course as a TA. TA won't be able to get access to respondus without teacher in the classroom. ET vs SIA roles and responsibilities.
